Ask and Tell: Ten Questions for Every Writing Project

- 1. What is the jurisdiction and what is the procedural status?
- 2. Should I consult other attorneys, review any specific work product, or consult an internal document bank?
- 3. Should I confirm the scope of the assignment in an email?
- 4. When should I first check in with you? After researching? After finding adverse authority or facts? After 20 hours? After a first draft?
- 5. About how long do you expect the final product to be?
- 6. About how many hours do you expect the project to require?
- 7. What authorities do you prefer? Print or electronic? Do you mind unpublished opinions? Do you want secondary sources?
- 8. Do you have formatting preferences (spacing, font, bold & italics, headings)? Any words or phrases you dislike but often see?
- 9. What's the deadline and is it flexible?
- 10. What do you intend to do with the final product?
